### California Proposition 65 Declaration and Compliance

Dear Valued Supplier,

In late 2016, the State of California adopted an amendment to the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, also known as “Prop 65”, which updates warning requirements for products sold in the State of California. These new regulations become effective in August 2018.

As a supplier to Bosch Automotive Service Solutions, Inc., (“Bosch”), Bosch expects you to review the list of chemicals identified by the State of California (<https://oehha.ca.gov/proposition-65/proposition-65-list>) and make a determination as to whether the products you provide must include a Prop 65 warning and correctly label your products, if required. In addition, we need you to confirm your compliance with Prop 65 as described below.

We are attaching the Bosch California Proposition 65 Declaration form for you to review, complete, and return to us via email [AA-AS\\_PROP65support@in.bosch.com](mailto:AA-AS_PROP65support@in.bosch.com) to verify your compliance. Please provide to the undersigned the following:

1. A completed declaration form that lists all substances above the safe harbor threshold and for each chemical above the threshold you need to identify the impact: *Cancer, reproductive harm or both*.
2. If any substances are at or above the safe harbor level, a description of the label that you will affix. It must describe:
  - a. A copy of the label format and content
  - b. Where the label will be affixed
  - c. The date the label will be on your supplied product

We require that you respond by **June 15, 2018** with both the required declaration file signed, labeling information and timing for when the appropriate labels will be affixed to the product. It is imperative that you assure Bosch that it can continue to supply our customers with products that comply with Prop 65. All products you supply to Bosch must have the labels affixed no later than **August 1, 2018** so we can assure your product will be available for future orders. All products ordered and delivered before August 1, 2018 must comply with current Prop 65 labeling requirements.

As part of the regular release process for all new or change parts / products, you need to confirm your compliance to Prop 65 and provide your response to the RFQ originator contact listed above with a copy of the completed Prop 65 declaration file for the affected items.
